WHAT TO BRING:

Bible, pens, notebook, warm clothes, jacket, towels, sportswear/tennis shoes, sleeping bag/ warm bedding and pillow, bug repellent, sunscreen, shampoo, soap, deodorant, comb/ brush, and plastic bags for clothes.

DO NOT BRING:

i-pods, cell phones, fireworks, knives, pop, candy, electronic games, illegal drugs, alcohol, cigarettes/e-cigarettes.

DRESS CODE:

Scripture tells us that our body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. Therefore it is camp policy that everyone wear clothes that are modest and honorable to God. Clothing displaying open midriffs, low cut, and revealing clothing is strictly prohibited. Only one piece swim suits will be allowed.

CANTEEN:

Registration includes the cost of the canteen except on June 20, 24, and 29. If campers wish to purchase things on these days they should bring extra money.

REQUIRED FORMS:

Law requires any person under 18 who attends camp must be free of communicable disease and immunized against measles, mumps, rubella, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, and polio. Each camper must have the Medical Certificate and Release Form, including medical history, allergies, medications, activity limitations and insurance information filled out and signed by a parent/guardian prior to admission to camp. All medications must be left with the camp nurse.
